### **Envirotech Wins RIA Phoenix Award for Innovation in Restoration**

Stoneham, MA (April 10, 2012) – Envirotech Clean Air, Inc. of Stoneham, Mass., was recently recognized as a winner of the national renowned Restoration Industry Association (RIA) Phoenix Award for Innovation in Restoration. The awards are presented each year to recognize achievement in the areas of restoration and reconstruction. Winning projects exemplify the complement of skills required to return a project to pre-loss condition and awards were presented at the Restoration Industry Association (RIA) Leadership Summit in Myrtle Beach, S.C. on March 28, 2012.

Envirotech was responsible for the cleaning, restoration and sealing of the HVAC mechanical systems at the Detroit Metropolitan Airport's FAA air traffic control tower. As one of eight companies comprising the Integrated Team, which collaborated on the remediation and restoration of fungal contamination throughout the tower and base building, the project at the nation's 25<sup>th</sup> busiest airport was completed while the tower continued operation. The project included the removal and replacement of approximately 115,000 square feet of gypsum wallboard material and nearly 20,000 square feet of one-inch thick elevator shaft liner board.

"Working in an active Air Traffic Control Tower takes a tremendous amount of coordination with the facility, the air traffic controllers, the electronics personnel, the industrial hygienists, the HVAC team, the general contractors and other stakeholders," said Senior Project Consultant and Envirotech Vice President Ron Fallon, CR, CMH. "Through careful collaboration we were able to work under controlled conditions while the building remained fully functional. That is a true tribute to the value of teamwork in a situation like this."

"Our focus during this project was always on the health of the air traffic controllers, tower workers and the safety of the workers involved in the remediation project," said Daniel Greenblatt, president of Envirotech Clean Air, Inc. "Knowing that the work made a very big difference in the lives and health of the air traffic

controllers was the most rewarding part of the project. However, the employees and management team of Envirotech are honored and proud to be recognized with the national Phoenix Award for Innovation in Restoration.”
